
## The "Hale Hole"

About 8 years ago a tree fell across and blocked Jones Creek (on the Virginia Highlands Horse Trail (VHHT) in the Hale Lake area). The water jumped into the trail and proceeded to scour it down to bedrock. The 300' washout was up to 5 feet deep in some places, carrying water in wet times, creating a dangerous situation for trail users and the environment. The BCHVH and ACC teamed up to find a solution to the problem and built the Project around it. The following pictures show the progress and results on the "Hale Hole". In total 8.5 mi. of the VHHT and 5 mi. of connecting trails will be improved by this project, made possible by a Legacy Trails Grant from American Trails.

## **Additional Accomplishments**


In July BCHVH worked on the Virginia Highlands Horse Trail at Jones Creek while the Appalachian Conservation Corps were up improving the Iron Mountain Trail above. The IMT had become overgrown with Rhododendron and the trail tread had all but disappeared. They brushed the entire 3 miles and had enough time to re-bench 0.6 miles. They will be back in the Spring of 2024 to finish up.

The BCHVH were able to access the middle of the remote trail through a partnership with a private land owner and worked improving the approach to the "Hale Hole" so that materials could be brought in during the September hitch. Also working in from Hwy 21, grading, repairing and constructing grade dips and improving the trail so the Forest Service could help us transport gravel 4 miles down the trail to stockpile for the project.

In September BCHVH joined forces with the ACC, AK Trails LLC and other volunteers to complete the 300' turnpike at the Hale Hole. At the same time a local excavator operator worked on drainage along the 8.5 mi. and AK Trails LLC put the finishing touches on the sustainability with a Ditch Witch trail dozer.


